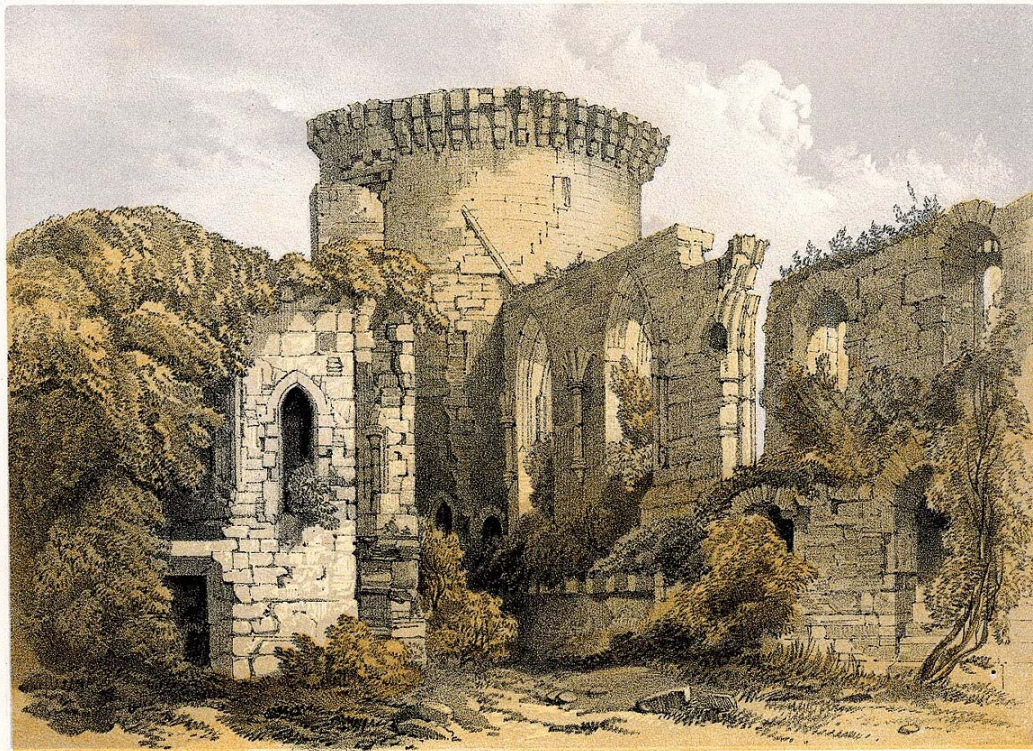

Sir John de Morteyn of Merston and Tilesworth, Beds. (**England**) (= Joan de Rothwell) *The Parliamentary Writs and Writs of Military Summons (1827), p. 747*

Sir John de Soules, Guardian of Scotland (1301-1304) [(Scotland); **probably not present in this battle**] (= **Hawise Stewart, d/o Alexander, 4th Steward of Scotland**) *Historic Environment Scotland (sub Lochmaben Castle) at <https://www.historicenvironment.scot/archives-and-research/publications/publication/?publicationId=4e3cf01f-2639-439e-b06a-a8b800d51fda> (which provides no information of his participation in this battle)*
