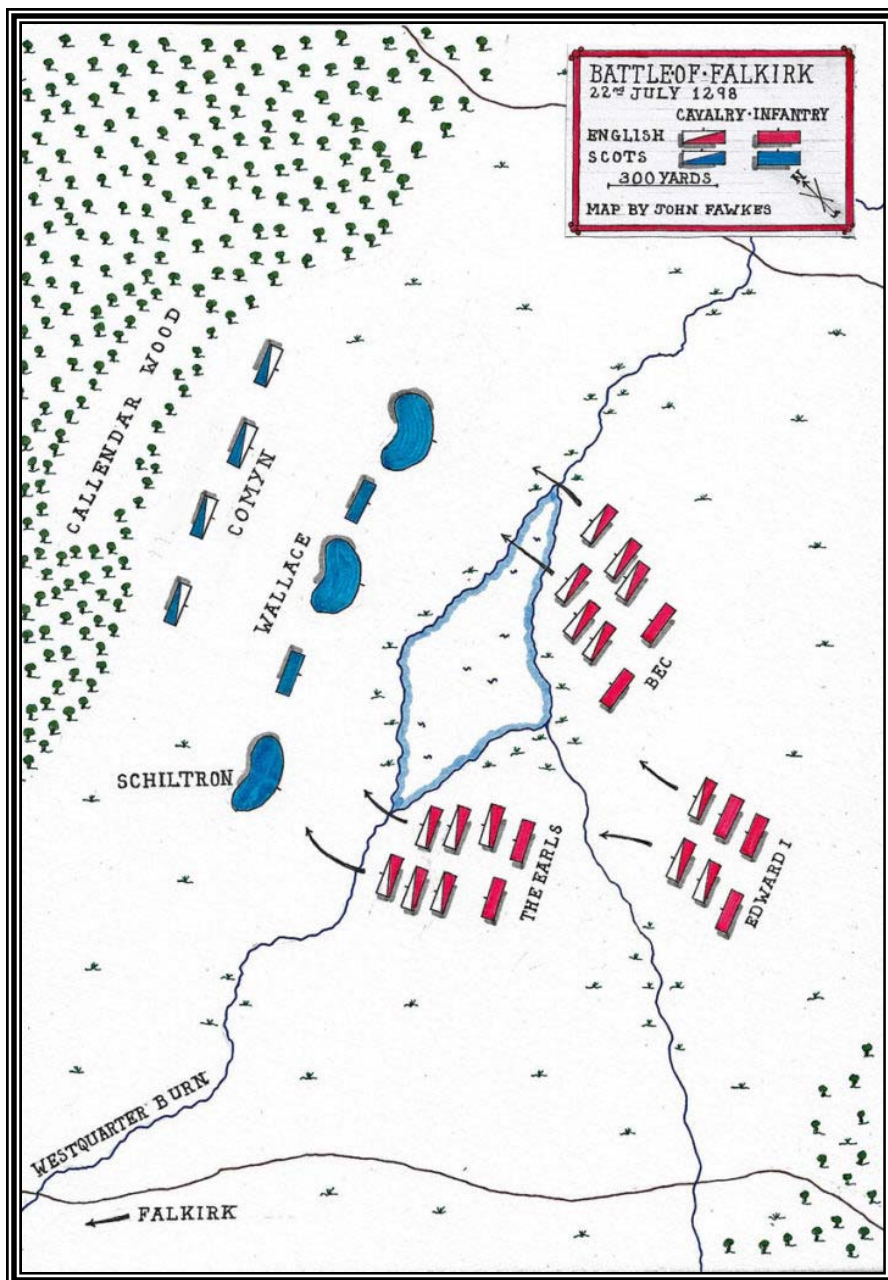

Sir John Comyn III (c. 1274-1036), Kt., “Red Comyn,” Lord of Badenoch, Guardian of Scotland (1299) [(Scotland) taken prisoner (1296-1297); stabbed to death by King Robert de Brus at Dumfries (1306); though his troops were present, his presence at this battle is uncertain; cousin of Sir John Comyn, 3rd Earl of Buchan, above, and son of John Comyn II, “Black Comyn” and Elenaor de Balliol] (= Joan de Valence) *Douglas Richardson, Royal Ancestry*, 5 vols.
